  - a) Review Plant Operator's Report on Flows, EDU's and Plant Performance
  - b) Beam Road
    - Reed Bed #1 solids and filter sand removal, replace with recycled glass media, replant reeds
      - Reed rhizomes and crushed glass are set up we should inspect glass material at Cougle's prior to installation
      - Bid document for removal being reviewed need bid document for installation of new media
      - Including removal of solids from 6 cells in reed bed #3 to level of other 4 cells
    - VFD upgrade project Public bidding completed on November 5th
    - RAS pinch valve #2 Appears to have leaking sleeve = no flow control. We ordered 2 new valves and will have RAS Valves 1 and 2 replaced at the same time. Scheduled for November 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - c) PennDOT / Collection System Repairs
    - PENNDOT SR 1046 Maple Grove Road. Ebert is creating scope of work and bid request. Ebert visited the site on June 10<sup>th</sup>. NLCA televised pipelines and manholes on June 25<sup>th</sup>.
      - <u>Location 1</u> in the intersection of Mill Street and Maple Grove Road divot in road near manhole. 80% sag on downstream side of manhole.
      - ► <u>Location 2</u> E Maple Grove Rd, 75 feet east of Church Street in front of address 157 Maple Grove Road Observed roadway sags between manholes 15207a and 15207. Also downstream of MH15207, including lateral to 157 Maple Grove Rd. (Attempted to televise on Oct 28<sup>th</sup> Tee to 4 inch pipeline coming out of cleanout appears offset or deflected)
    - Fivepointville Manhole in 5-way intersection has some movement at top riser. Ebert observed on June 10<sup>th</sup>.
    - 8 inch main north of Lauschtown Rd leak at MH17006 and sag between MH17004 and MH17005
    - PENNDOT called on August 5, 2025 to notify us that they received a complaint about roadway sags on Rt 625 near 1341 and 1337 Reading Rd (just south of Lauschtown Rd). Matt observed roadway and Norm reviewed televising.
    - Pipeline near bridge on Bowmansville Rd Requested Ebert to prepare scope of work for repair
  - d) Package Plant Tank Linings -
    - Received proposals from Advanced Rehabilitation Technology and Abel Recon
  - e) 108 East Black Creek Rd 1 new LP connection.
    - PADEP approved exemption from 537 modification
    - Need Developer's Agreement executed
  - f) Boulder Hill Rd potential for one additional connection. Can have clean out installed for flushing.
  - g) 1576 Reading Rd Need plan review and Developer's Agreement from Ebert 1 additional EDU
